These hotels are adjacent to each other on Riverside Drive, downtown Windsor. It's about a 20-30-minute walk along riverfront paths to/from campus or a 5-7 minute bus ride. The downtown bus terminal is directly behind both hotels.

Attendees can access the group rate 3 days prior or 3 days after the conference for an extended stay in Windsor.

Train:

Windsor's VIA Rail train station is in the historic Hiram Walker Distillery District, which is a short cab or bus ride from downtown. There are four daily departures and return trips along the Windsor-Toronto corridor. https://www.viarail.ca/en

Bus:

FlixBus runs routes from 8 cities to Windsor and a cross-border route from Union Station in Toronto to the Detroit Bus Station, with a stop in Windsor (8 Goyeau St). https://www.flixbus.ca/
